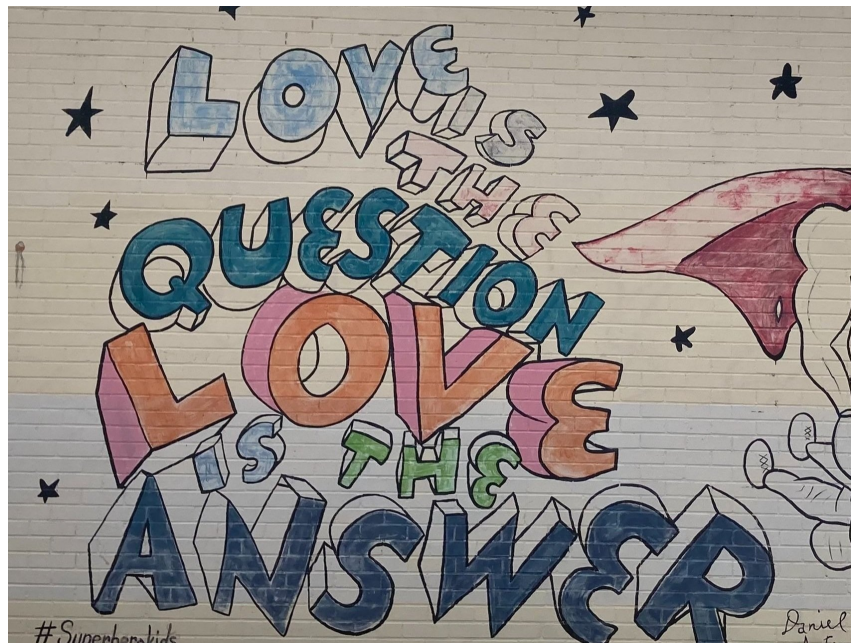


GRACE
